You may be creative when describing your "discovery," but the manuscript must be complete and as close to a real manuscript as possible. Typically, the discovery is introduced, methods used to make the discovery are described, experiments performed are covered, data is presented, conclusions are discussed, and potential applications of the discovery are covered. Length of your Letter does not need to exceed two pages.
